
1. Model using the background cards by telling your own story. You may want to start by choosing a mood for your story: for example, is it a happy story? Is it sad or scary? Then, select an appropriate background card, and add characters and events. Encourage the children to do the same, providing story starters if needed.




2. Ask the children to build a scene showing what they did on the weekend or during a vacation. Then have them describe their scene to a friend



3. Put some of the special elements in a bag (for example, a crocodile, horse, girl, and boy) and have the children pick one to three elements out of the bag with their eyes closed. Then, invite the children to build a story using the selected elements as the main character(s).
