



## How we did it

12 kids from the US went into a room (the adults said it was called a 'FOCUS GROUP'). They asked us to help write a survey about AI. Then we sent it to 800 kids in the US, Germany, South Korea, and Australia so we could hear what THEY think.




If we could control

**89%** of us

when using AI

# But there's a humongous problem: nobody asks us what we think




83% of us confirm:
