

Getting Started

This activity card will help you introduce the People set to your preschoolers. The activities are designed to familiarize children with the set. After completing these activities, you can create more fun learning experiences by combining the people figures with other early learning solutions from LEGO® Education.



1. Professions

Ask each child to pick a figure and talk about its profession. Start a discussion about why these professions are needed in your community. Remember to use any appropriate accessories to support a particular profession.



2. Creating a family

Have each child pick a child figure and create a family for him or her. Ask them to introduce the whole family to the rest of the children by sharing things, like:

- His or her name
- His or her parents and what they do for work and fun
- His or her siblings' names and hobbies



3. My good friend

Ask each child to pick their favorite figure and tell the rest of the class:

- Who it is (i.e., their name)
- Their age
- What they like or dislike
- Why they're good friends

4. My future job

Randomly put different accessories on the child figures and ask the children what these child figures' dream jobs could be. Have a group discussion about what the children would like to do when they grow up, and why. Encourage each child to pick a figure that represents their future dream job.



5. Who's that?

Ask one child to describe a particular LEGO DUPLO® figure, while the rest of the children have to guess the right figure based on their classmate's description (e.g., hair color, eye color, gender, clothes).

Children will:

- Understand diversity in family structures
- Understand the roles and responsibilities of people in their community
- Be able to describe familiar people, with prompting and support
- Be able to clearly express thoughts and ideas
