• Design and make the bus that will take Carrie to work.




Suggested model solution


Contemplate

- As the children build, ask them to consider what features a bus should have and get them to check if their bus lives up to the following: ticketing, timetables, seats, room for the bus driver, easy access, luggage racks, etc.
- Ask the children to talk about what identifies their bus as a local bus that takes passengers on a specific route.
- Ask the children to list the various types of buses used for different purposes, such as school buses, long distance coaches, tour buses, sightseeing busses, double-deckers, etc.

Continue

- A bus travels along a specific route. It stops to take people on board and let them off again. It stops at regular stops. Design and make a bus stop with stop signs and a shelter for people to wait for the bus.
- It is very nice to sit on top of a double-decker bus when sightseeing
 in big cities. It's the ideal place for viewing and taking photos of all
 the sights. Change your bus into an open top bus, or design and make
 a new open top bus to take passengers on a sightseeing tour.
